You may have heard through older brothers or friends or read in past *Lampstand* magazines of the five very successful reunions we have held at Wellington College to celebrate 'Forty Years On'. Old Boys from 1964, 1965, 1966, 1967, 1968 and 1969 have assembled forty years on at Wellington College and have enjoyed a weekend of reminiscing and nostalgia. Attendees have included a number from overseas. The 40 Years On Reunion programme has gathered great momentum since its inception.

All six year groups have strongly urged that the 40 Year On Reunions continue. The banter between the Firth House and Day Boys, demonstrations of Hakas, remembering nicknames/mannerisms of staff, the traditional matches, Quadrangular Tournament and school productions to name a few have been fondly recalled over each weekend.

Accordingly, I am writing to you to ask if you will take up the challenge of the previous year groups by attending a reunion for your year group. The 1966-1970 tenure includes those whose third form year was in 1966 (not necessarily at Wellington College) and left before, during or at the end of 1970 (thus Forty Years On). This includes those who started in 1965 and stayed on until 1970 and those who stayed on until 1971.

The format we have run for the past six years has proved successful, and caters for both Old Boys and partners. The 40 Years On weekend is 15-16 October 2010 in order to have the current students in attendance for the College Assembly and to bypass Labour Weekend.

I have included an alphabetical list based on the 1966-1970 Wellingtonians of those students who were at the College in this era. Firstly, please let me know if I have overlooked anybody and secondly, if you can assist in locating any of those listed without current addresses. I have purposely omitted full mailing addresses at this stage as a privacy issue. However, I have indicated the town or city we have recorded for them. I have also enclosed email addresses for your reference.

I would also appreciate you providing me with your full details overleaf so I can update our database at the same time. In many cases, registration cards omitted second names, dates of birth etc and it is quite difficult to source that information without your help. We also have Old Boys recorded as deceased and in some cases, this may well

be incorrect or in others, we just may not be aware of someone's demise.

I look forward to your earliest response, either by email or in writing.
