Funding for WCPA

We had aimed to meet with Cam from the board prior to issuing a letter around our

proposal to introduce a WCPA levy - but did not manage to get a meeting yet.

Will send off our proposal and copy Pat Smith as he has voiced his support as teacher rep.

The proposed funding, \$15 per boy per term, will assist in the goal of creating community by assisting fund events, but also potentially fund much needed assets or improvements

around the school that existing funding streams don't cover. One initiative is to get the

coffee cart fixed and operational again for hospitality and fundraising, another is the

purchase of a school van. Note that this will be a voluntary donation and it will be made

clear it is optional. Libby noted that generally a very high payment rate.

WCPA Awareness

The question was raised about WCP having a social media presence. Tama noted there

are three controlled school FB pages - general through school office Claire Shakespere

maintains this, and for example WCP meetings are posted on that, another facebook

group each for sport/arts. Probably best to stay with promoting through the main school

channels and WCP does also have a presence on the web-site which we could update

via the school.

Executive Report to the May 2023 AGM

It has been a strange couple of years for the Wellington College Parents Association (WCPA) with Covid and the change of Headmaster having a major impact on how the group works. However, with a renewed focus on what we can do vs what we weren't able to do, we have taken the opportunity to rejuvenate the WCPA and have started afresh.

In March 2023, we held a "return to the WCPA" meeting which had a fantastic turnout and through the hard work of Megan Bibby we have managed to cement the future of the WCPA and to start building a new vision for the group.

We have agreed the first two major events for the year, being a Grandparents Day (30 May and 1 June) and a "Big Boys Breakfast" scheduled for the week 7-11 August 2023.

We hope these will become marquee events for the College and provide a way for our parents and caregiver community to connect better with the boys and the College.

This year the Year 9 students and whanau were welcomed to the school in a different way where they were welcomed at an evening meeting and the boys got the opportunity to introduce their families to their Deans and to their fellow tutor group students. We also had the opportunity to speak to the group and introduce the concept of joining the WCPA. This had a highly successful outcome and we are encouraged that we have a voice with the College's Senior Leadership Team as we had long pushed for this style of introduction to the school. We hope this continues for years to come.

In the background there has been a significant project undertaken by the Wellington College Old Boy's Association looking at all the fundraising and friend-raising initiatives that happen in the school and how we can harness all of those efforts, reduce crossover and create a centralised approach to how this bit of

the community operates. This piece of work was conducted by Giving Architects and we look forward to seeing some of that work start to unfold over the next 12 months.

We will continue to work with the Senior Leadership Team, the Board, the Old Boys' Association and other communities in the school to ensure we are aligned in our objectives, that we maximise opportunities for everyone and to create an environment that is positive and conducive to parents and caregivers being more connected to the school.

Our Executive Team has been small but forceful and special acknowledgement should go to Chris Nicholls who is stepping down from the role of Chair and to Megan Bibby (Secretary) who has been instrumental in driving the new direction for the WCPA.

We extend a heartfelt acknowledgement to our Headmaster, Glen Denham, and the senior leadership team, especially Dave Keat, Tama Smith, Phil Bergin and Pat Smith for their time and dedication. They each give their time to the WCPA to provide us with an update on what's happening across the school. On behalf of the WCPA, we'd like to thank them all for giving up their personal time to do this for us.

Whilst the past year has not provided us any opportunity to host events, we are focussed on delivering quality events this year for our community.
