## UNIFORM GUIDELINES - THE COLL WAY

UPDATED FOR 2026. ALL STUDENTS WILL BE WEARING THE REFRESHED UNIFORM BY 2028.

### At WC Year 9 - 11s:

- wear the refreshed school uniform with blazer and tie (blazer should be worn while transitioning to classes, and to and from school)
- wear pants or shorts
- wear plain black polishable shoes with black socks (no sandals allowed)
- wear the school raincoat

### At WC Year 12 - 13s:

- wear the refreshed school uniform or the former school uniform
- wear plain black polishable shoes with black socks (no sandals allowed)
- if wearing a jacket, it must be plain black, with minimal branding
- can wear the black jersey with the grey uniform

### At WC we do not:

- wear hoodies, vests, or non-regulation jackets
- wear extremes of hairstyle (including unnatural colours)
- wear any visible T-shirts under our uniform
- wear jewellery except for a small, non-decorative single stud in each ear
- wear any non-regulation clothing, hats, scarves, or shoes
- wear sandals

### At WC all students:

- wear shirts tucked in
- have clean-shaven faces
- can wear cultural taonga
- wear black socks pulled up to the knee
- wear plain black polishable shoes with black socks with shorts and pants
- wear a black leather belt when wearing shorts or pants
- wear long hair tied up
